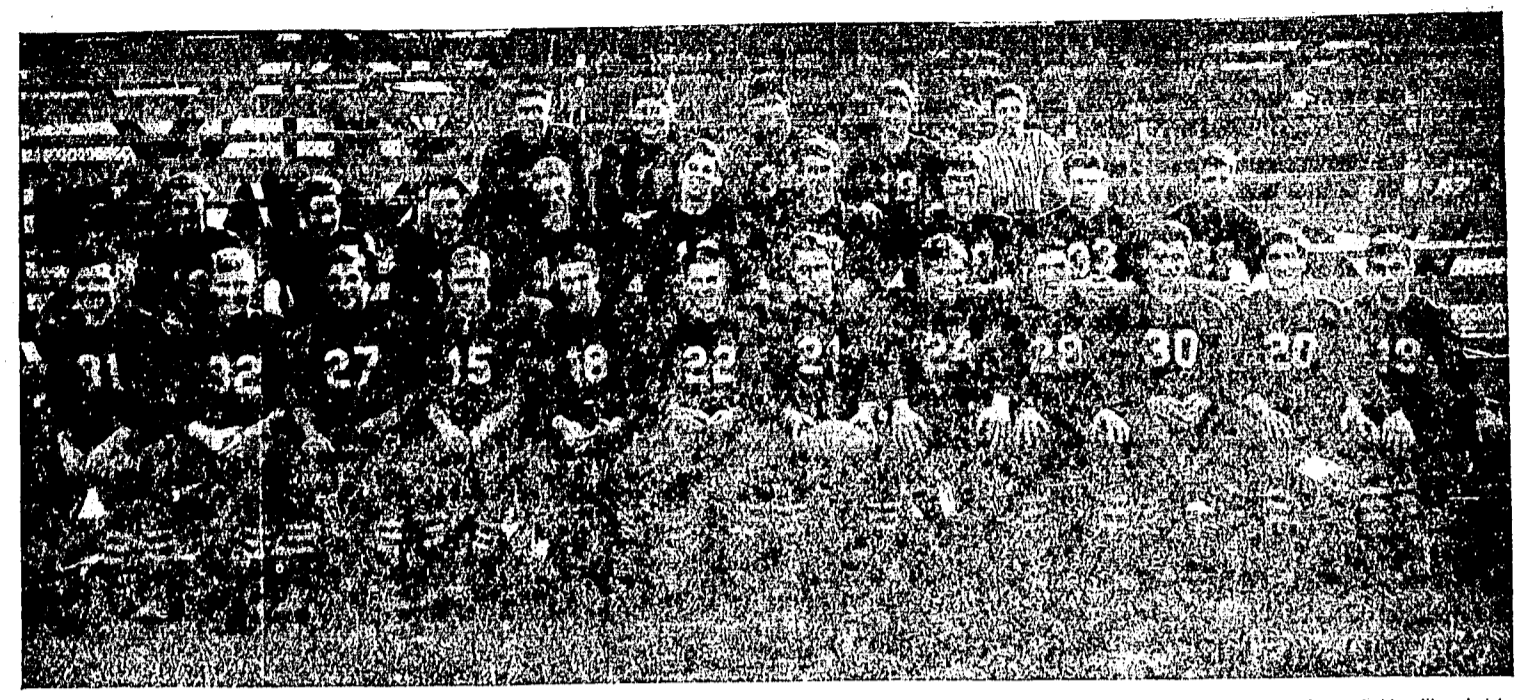

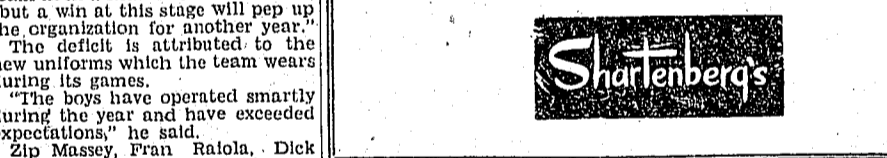

STRATFORD RAMS SCORE EARLY TO MEASURE LAURELS

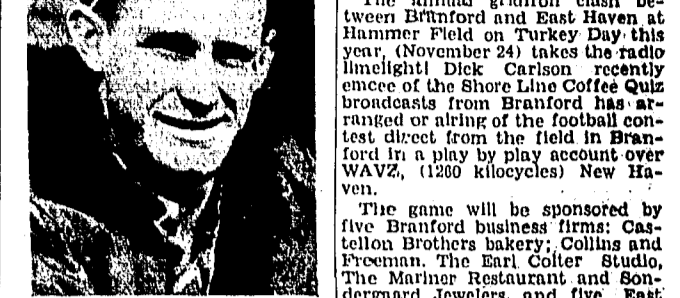
