Fire Officials Warn Citizens Of Xmas Fires

Fire Chief, John Zvonkovic and Fire Marshal, Eric Wood, of the Branford Fire Department, this week issued the following statement of fire prevention during the coming holidays:

Christmas trees and decorations are responsible each year for many fires which can be avoided by simple precautions. The decoration of trees in rooms relative to other contents, the type of decorations, the electric line lighting, and the use of extension cords and proper fuses.

Only freshly cut trees should be used, and they should be kept fresh by being set in water or wet sand. The base of the tree should be cut at an angle above the original cut, or deep cuts sawed lengthwise at the base of the trunk should be added to keep the water level above these cuts.

The room in which the tree is placed should be kept as cool and well ventilated as possible. The tree should not be located near a stove, radiator or other source of heat.

HEARING TESTS ARE GIVEN TO CONN. CHILDREN

Connecticut's children have been given 9,668 individual hearing tests with puretone audiometers by the Bureau of Mental and Child Hygiene of the State Department of Health, Florence A. Browne, D. H. reports in the December Health Bulletin.

HEARING TESTS are given chiefly to three groups of children: pre-school children in the first three grades, the "detected" group includes those children who have failed to pass group audiometer tests given under auspices of the state department of education; it also includes children suspected of hearing loss by parents or teachers because of inattention or poor school work.

Dr. Browne concludes her preliminary report with a testimonial to the physicians of the state, especially certain otologists, for their generosity in treatment without remuneration of these hard-of-hearing children in the absence of adequate clinic facilities.

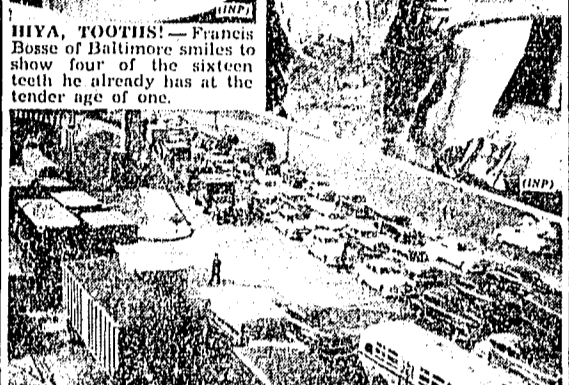
