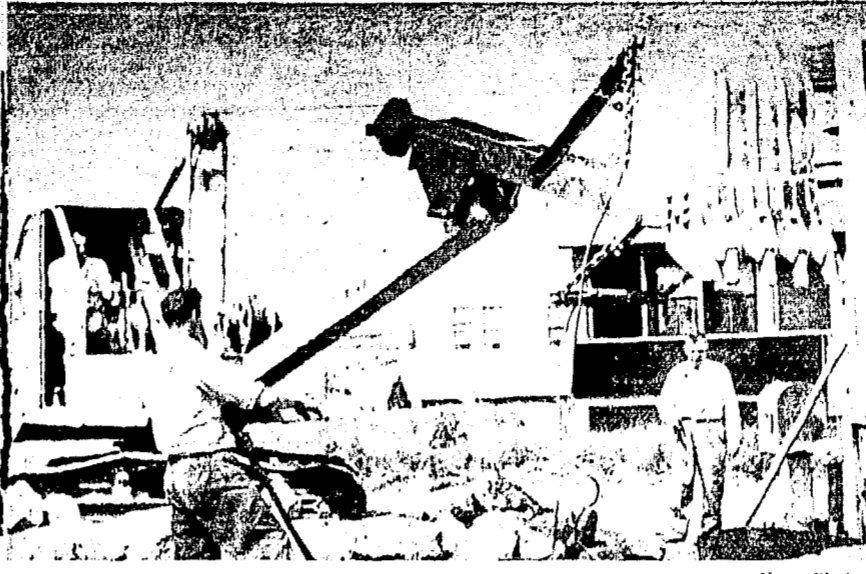

3-billion In U. S. Orders Placed In State For '52

Hartford—Military prime contracts placed in Connecticut passed the \$3-billion mark in the fourth quarter of 1952 and sped to a figure of \$3,292,590,000, the State Development Commission reported today. Citing information received from the federal Munitions Board, the commission said that from the start of Korean hostilities in June, 1950, through last December, Connecticut had received 4.2% of \$77.7 billion worth of defense orders which the government has distributed by states.

The business agency said the state ranks ninth among the states in total contracts, but far outdoes any other state in proportion to its size. Connecticut's military orders amount to \$1.61 for every man, woman and child in the state. On the same person basis, Michigan is next with \$1.292. The navy has spent far more in Connecticut than any other armed service, the commission noted. "The admirals alone have placed slightly more than \$2 billion worth of defense business in the state," it said, adding, "they
