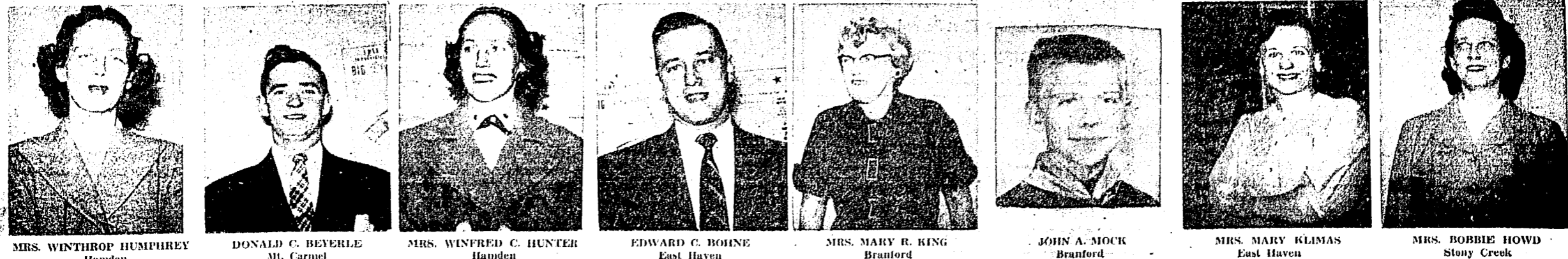

The problem is a tough one. East Haven doesn't count among the volunteer fire companies. Without their ready assistance, this town would be in grave danger. As much as a nuisance as it is, this vulgar-sounding horn is an important instrument in our defense against fire.

What has heightened Mr. Brown's, and no doubt other residents', irritation has been the huge number of grass and brush fires that are typical of the season.

A check back will reveal that a very large percentage of these fires are caused by faulty incinerators. Some time ago Fire Chief Hayes and Fire Marshal Ernest Hansen endorsed the enactment of a local ordinance enforcing the use of properly built incinerators.

No action was taken on the matter because the ordinance-making is within the province of the board of selectmen. Secondly, the proposal was lost in the welter of other matters and problems with which the board of selectmen had been busy.

It might be, then, that a partial solution to the problem could be found in a regulation requiring every motorist to have a fire extinguisher in his car.

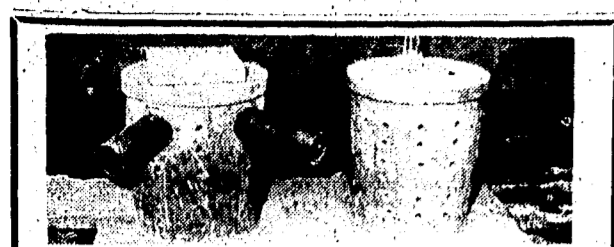

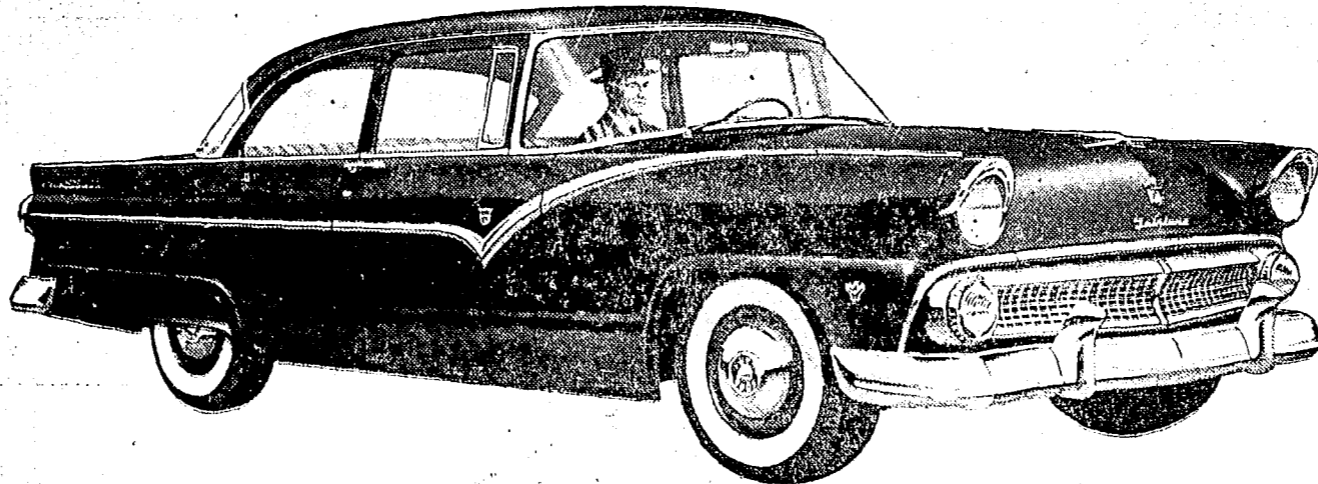

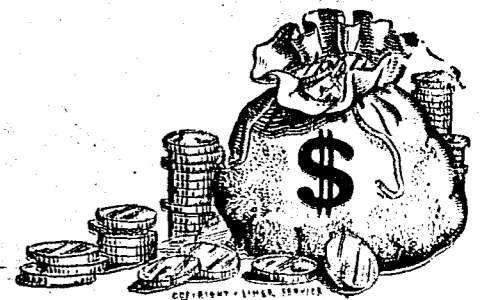
