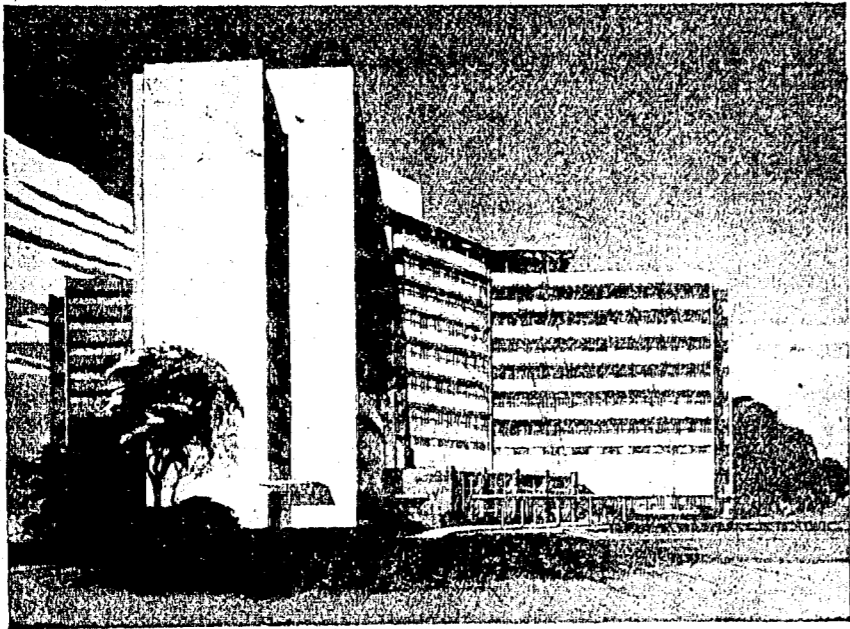

GRACE-NEW HAVEN HOSPITAL PROJECT NEEDS \$1,500,000

Completion of Grace-New Haven Community Hospital's new 325-bed unit, a project which will relieve the pressure upon the entire hospital system of this area...

This was the substance of the message given to about 250 interested residents of New Haven and neighboring communities by speakers at a dinner on Thursday, November 16, at the Hotel Taft.

Meanwhile, construction of the new hospital building in a block adjoining the New Haven Hospital plant is proceeding apace. In addition to beds for 325 adult and child patients...

Important products of the association between the hospital and the school: natural childbirth and lying-in; the work resulting from cooperation with the State Commission on Care for the Chronically Ill...

That the school is — and has been — doing all in its power to advance medicine and raise the level of hospital care was emphasized by Dr. Francis C. Blake, head of the school's department of internal medicine and former dean.

In his address, Mr. Welsh voiced confidence that the additional \$1,500,000 required to complete the building will be contributed by the health-conscious people of this area.

Other speakers at the dinner were Mayor William C. Celestano of New Haven, Dr. Luther K. Musselman, chief of staff of general services, and the Rev. Sidney Lovett, president of the New Haven Community Chest.

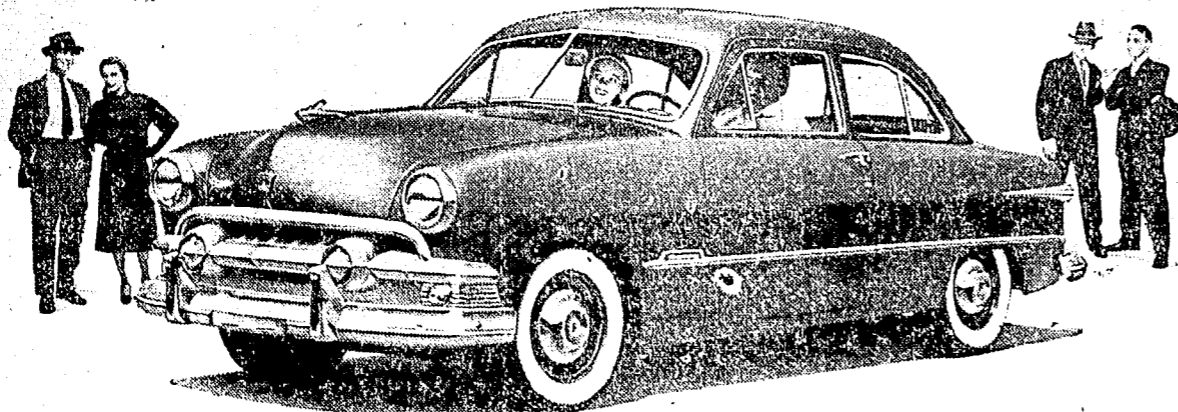
