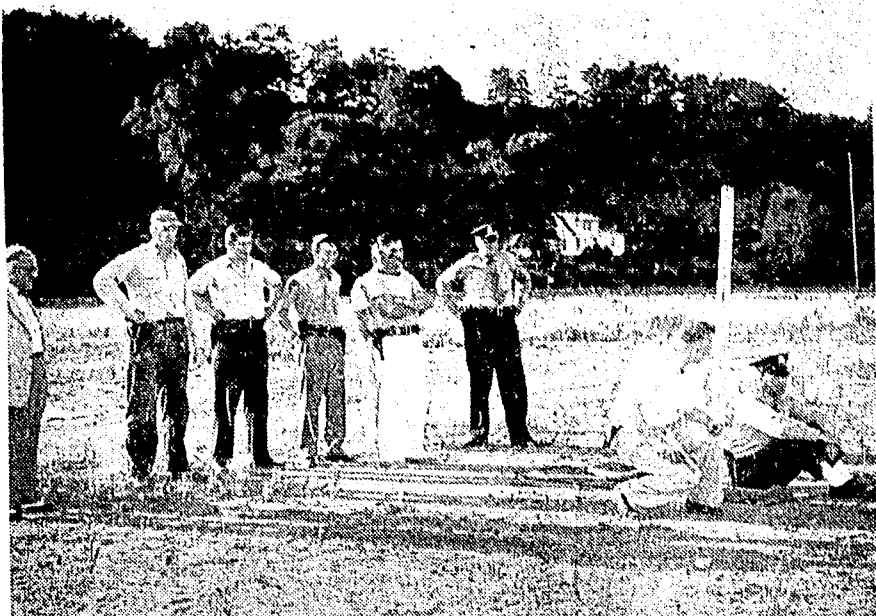

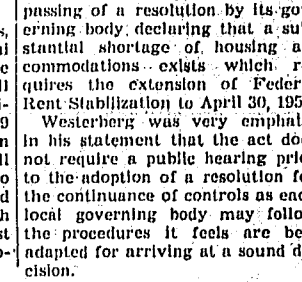

### Start Them Younger

Four universities are busy now doing some things for the young men who will be called up for military service. Chicago, Columbia, Wisconsin and Yale have a program to get the youth off to at least a two year start on a liberal education before they reach the 18-year-old draft age.

Here is but a realistic approach to the problem of education versus national military service. The present practice of deferring college students has put them in a class which is in itself a handicap which calls upon education to give them the opportunity to study after the privilege of completing their courses.

It is necessary because the country needs college-trained men. However, the inequality which financial considerations enters the picture.

It colleges can give the youths at least half their education before they enter service, along with the non-college boys, the practice will help to reduce the inequity, keep alive the desire for more education and retain a crop of college-trained men.

The pre-service education will go far to prepare the youngsters for active leadership in the service. The service itself will help to mature the men for the serious continuation of their education.

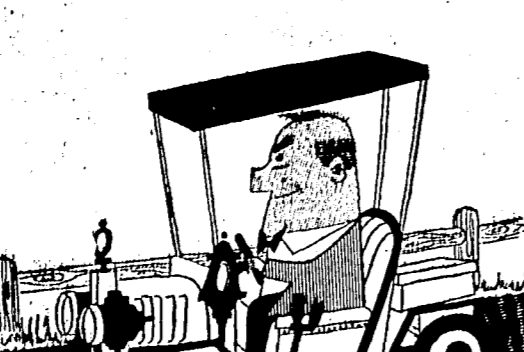
